EXTENSIVE DAMAGE

Examples of Extensive Damage

Major vehicle component failure:

- engine damage;
- airbag replacement;
- engine control unit (ECU) replacement;
- transmission failure; and,
- steering pump replacement.

Major structural damage:

 when any part of the vehicle which is part of the main body or frame, or is designed to ensure structural integrity, is damaged.

Major paint/finish defects or flaws:

- significant peeling, bubbling or other finish flaws on newer vehicles; and
- significant rust perforations.

Overall poor condition:

- when a vehicle has not received proper maintenance and significant repairs are necessary to bring the vehicle to average condition. A combination (three or more) of the following may be considered <u>if completed within 30 days of</u> the date of purchase:
 - complete replacement of front/rear brakes and front/rear brake components;
 - manifold gaskets or exhaust gaskets;
 - drive axles;
 - small bearings, bushings or seals;
 - glass chips or cracks that occur in the wiper line;
 - missing and/or damaged mirrors and/or headlight assemblies; and
 - o other repairs necessary to bring the vehicle to average condition.
