

Property Tax Deferral Program for Seniors Agreement Deregistration Form

To deregister from the deferral program, complete this form and return to the address indicated above. Completion of this form will deregister your deferral account effective the date we receive it. Once your account is deregistered, the province will no longer defer the annual property tax increase on the Property and the total unpaid tax deferral plus the associated interest will become due and payable to the Province. Upon receipt of a completed deregistration form and full payment, the lien on the property will be released. **Note:** Legal representatives may sign on behalf of a participant(s), provided a valid Power of Attorney declaration is attached.
