1. When using Adobe to view the Historical Index, if you want to see two pages without a break:

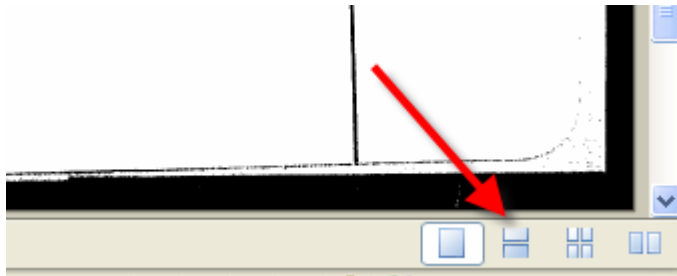

- When you are **printing pdf's in PLANET** and you are printing from a .pdf that has markups on it, if you want to print the markups, you have to adjust the settings of your printer in order to get the markup printed too
